
AND WHAT WILL THIS HELP FUND:

Academic Year 2023-24



One of our ongoing fundraisers is the HSA **Lucky Lotto (200 Club)**. It is a monthly school lottery – a quick and easy way to support our schools.

It's just **£1 per month, per ticket!** You can pick as many tickets as you wish.

The HSA Lucky Lotto (200 Club) gives 3 lucky winners a chance to share half of the stake money – 25% to the winner, 15% for second place and 10% for third place. 50% of the money goes to the schools and the other 50% represents the prize pot; so the more you play the more you can win!

The money raised helps to fund all the things that help enrich the children's education at both

Harnham Junior and Harnham Infant schools.

You can buy as many tickets as you wish as long as you are over 16 years of age. It is open to parents, teachers, governors, relatives and friends – so spread the word!
