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- ❖ Thursday 27th June, morning Forest School session parents are invited to accompany their child to our Forest School for their initial get-together. The specific time for this event will be included in your child's starting school pack (available from 7.6.24)
- ❖ Friday 5th July, time tbc Workshop in the school hall parents are invited to accompany their child to our school hall to take part in some fun activities with their new class friends. The specific time for this event will be included in your child's starting school pack (available from 7.6.24)
- ❖ Tuesday 9th July, morning Visit to the classroom children are invited to come to school to visit their classroom with their class teacher. Tea and Coffee will be provided for parents in the hall and to get to know other parents or chat to a member of the Senior Leadership Team, who will be available to answer any questions you may have. The specific time for this event will be included in your child's starting school pack (available from 7.6.24)
- ❖ Wednesday 4th, Thursday 5th and Friday 6th September Home visits. Teachers and Teaching Assistants will come and visit the children in their home environments. The specific date and time for this will be given to you at workshop in the hall event on 5.7.24.
- ❖ Monday 9th September Children are invited to begin attending school, full time. (Part time options can be discussed with the class teacher on an individual basis)
