For the HSA to make sure enough tea towels are ordered, please PRE-ORDER BY MONDAY 3RD MARCH via the School Gateway app, you can find it under the Payments section.

# **HOW TO PRE-ORDER**

As each school are producing their own whole school tea towel if you have children in both schools, you will need to purchase a tea towel from each school to be able to see their portraits on a tea towel.

#### **INFANT SCHOOL ORDERING**

If you would like to pre-order more than one please indicate this in the amount you pay.

For example if you wish to order 2 tea towels, please pay £8; if you wish to order 3 tea towels, please pay £12 etc.

#### JUNIOR SCHOOL ORDERING

If you would like to order more than one you will need to action the payment multiple times.


For example if you wish to order 2 tea towels, you have to pay for one (£4), then the payment option will reappear and you can then place the second order (£4).
