The next HSA Meeting is due to take place on Thursday 3<sup>rd</sup> February. We do hope you will be able to come and get involved.

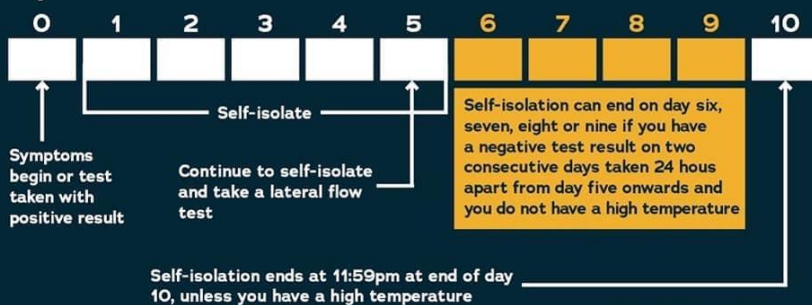
### Parent Support Advisor Contact:
