Emails:

The teachers are seeing an increase in the number of emails they are getting from parents. Whilst we pride ourselves on effective communication with parents in our school, please do not expect a teacher to see, and respond to, an email from you during the school day as they are busy teaching. Likewise, teachers do not mind you emailing during the evening or at the weekend, but please be mindful and understand they will not always respond straight away.

Names:

Please ensure that all children have their name written on their jumper or cardigan. With the warmer weather, children are taking them off and they are getting left on the playground or around school. These are easier to return to the right owner if they are named.

Staff on the Gates / Playground:

The staff on duty in the mornings, whether on a gate or on the playground are there to welcome the children. They will happily receive any quick messages from you, such as someone else collecting etc, but if you require a longer conversation, please email or telephone through the school office to book an appointment. Thank you.
