Pupil Premium

Have your financial circumstances changed? Do you think you might be eligible for further financial support? If your family claims certain benefits, your child may be eligible for the Pupil Premium Grant. This can often be confusing as it is also known as 'Free School Meals' but of course, every child at Harnham Infant School is entitled to Free School Meals. However, if you qualify for the Pupil Premium Grant, school will also be able to support you with other costs such as paying for school uniform, paying for school trips and for your child to attend an extra-curricular club too. 

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

Eligibility Criteria

Courses are free for learners aged 19+ (as of 31 August), living in Wiltshire, and meet certain residency requirements.

- On a lower income, earning less than £25,750 a year
- · Care leaver, foster carer, carer, refugee
- · Have a learning difficulty or disability
- · Not in work and looking to go into work, now or in the future
- In receipt of benefits (other than child benefit)
- Military family / ex-armed forces personnel
- Have school-aged children who receive means-tested free school meals
