- Research shows that children who miss one of the first few days of the new term for unauthorised reasons are much more likely to miss long periods of their schooling than their peers who attended those first few days. These children had a predicted overall absence of almost 45%, or 31 days across the term. This shows just how important it is that children are at school, ready to learn in the first days of the September term.




